JKCA ISSUES THE TALENT HUNT TRIAL SCHEDULE FOR JAMMU PROVINCE

In a press release issued at Jammu, Jammu & Kashmir Cricket Association has announced the Talent Hunt schedule for Jammu Province. Mr. Mithun Manhas, Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA, while announcing the schedule stated that as announced earlier, the Jammu Province has been divided in 4 zones. The venue wise details of Zones of Jammu are:

Zone 4	Samba & Jammu	Science College, Hostel Ground, Jammu	08 am

Schedule of the various camps is as follow:

1.	U19 (INCL U16) OD & DAYS.	6 th May to 8 th May
2.	U23 OD	9 th May to 10 th May
3.	Seniors OD & DAYS	11 th May to 13 th May

The same schedule will be followed for Talent Hunt trials for women also, said Mr Sunil Sethi, Member, Legal Affairs. He further stated that the trials will be held in whites for men and in coloured clothing for women. The trials will commence everyday at the given venue & time, players are advised to report at the designated venue well before the given time. As intimated earlier, each player has to bring with him digitized DOB certificate, School leaving certificate/marksheet/other documents will not be accepted as DOB proof. The cut off dates for the various age groups are:

- a. U-23 – Born on or after 01 September, 1999
- b. U-19 – Born on or after 01 September, 2003
- c. U-16 – Born on or after 01 September, 2006

Brig Anil Gupta, Member Administration reiterated that separate trials for U16 category is not planned but each U19 team will have minimum three players from this category. He also clarified that a player cannot give trials for more than two formats.

JKCA hopes that maximum budding players will avail this opportunity and at the end of it we would have enough new faces available for further camps. Each player is advised to bring the following certificate duly signed by their parents/guardians:

“I _____ father/mother/guardian of _____ hereby certify that he/she is voluntary participating in the J&K Cricket Association talent hunt trials for the age group _____ which is being held at _____ on _____. I have no objection if my son/ward participates in the said talent hunt trials and subsequent tournament, if selected. JKCA will not be responsible in case any mishap occurs during the trials/tournaments”
